NARRATIVE:

Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office deputies were summoned to 1884 Violet Avenue within unincorporated West Palm Beach, Palm Beach County, FL., in reference a shooting. An off-duty Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office Deputy observed Janeen M. McKenzie who is personally known to him, holding a black semi-automatic pistol while shooting towards a black male victim, Anthony Santos, who was kneeling on the street with his hands up. The deputy ordered McKenzie to drop the firearm several times before McKenzie complied. The deputy ordered McKenzie to return to her home. The off-duty deputy secured McKenzie's firearm until other P.B.S.O. deputies arrived. The victim left the scene but was located on the adjacent street. The victim was transported to the hospital where a bullet fragment was removed from his head. Witness interviews revealed that McKenzie exited the home and shot several times at the victim.

Santos provided a sworn statement indicating the following: He met McKenzie hours earlier while socializing at the Kings Lounge in unincorporated Lake Worth. McKenzie was consuming alcohol and due to her intoxication level, she requested he drive her home using her own vehicle. Santos agreed and asked his friend to drive his car and follow behind in order to pick him up from McKenzie's home. While en-route he learned that McKenzie's resides near his friend's apartment, so he planned on walking home from McKenzie's house. Upon the arrival at McKenzie's home, he assisted her by making sure she made it into the home. She invited him to stay and socialize with her for a while. They entered the home and McKenzie poured a glass of wine and continued consuming alcohol. They engaged in conversations which lead to kissing and McKenzie showing him her bedroom. McKenzie insisted he drink some of her wine. He took a sip and placed the glass down. After spending a few minutes in the bedroom, they walked back to the hallway where McKenzie continued flirting with him. She backed her body up against his, kissed and hugged him. Santos stated that McKenzie pulled him closer, grabbed his hands and placed them on her upper chest; just below the neck.

Then, McKenzie pulled his hands onto her neck, closing the gap around his hands and her neck while making a facial gesture suggesting she achieved pleasure from being choked during romantic encounters. Santos said he immediately pulled his hands away, looked at her confused, and proceeded to leave the home because "things were getting weird".

McKenzie walked to the kitchen and poured a second glass of wine. Noticing that McKenzie was intoxicated, he moved her hand from the glass of wine, told her she had enough, and instructed her to go sleep after he left. McKenzie's attitude changed. She asked him to look inside a drawer of an old wooden nightstand within dining area. Upon looking in the drawer, he observed a black semi-automatic pistol. Immediately, he shut the drawer and proceeded to leave. As he walked toward the front door, he heard the gun's slide move back and forward. He turned and saw McKenzie holding the firearm sideways, pointing it toward him. He noticed the gun had a bullet stuck in the ejection port. He asked McKenzie not to pull the trigger or she would blow them both up.

McKenzie disregarded his statement by saying whatever as she flailed the gun around; while pointing towards him. McKenzie said he didn't think the gun was real. He acknowledged the gun was real and said she was going to kill them both. She looked down at the gun and realized a bullet was lodged in the ejection port. At this point, he took the chance to get away. As he walked towards the front door, he heard the gun's slide move back and the bullet fall on the floor. He looked back and noticed McKenzie now had the ability to shoot him. He recalls making just outside the door, as McKenzie continued to point the gun toward his direction while flailing her arms. As McKenzie waved the gun, within feet of his face, she pulled the trigger. The shot was so close his face felt as if he was burnt by the blast. The shot momentarily incapacitated him; leaving his ears ringing.


He questioned McKenzie's action and she said, yeah get out on the street. He explained to her that he was already out of her house and on the street. McKenzie ordered him to the ground several times but he refused. As he walked away, McKenzie fired at him. The projectile struck the asphalt and the debris struck his neck. He turned toward McKenzie and asked her to go back into the house and leave him alone. McKenzie shot at him a third time, striking the asphalt roadway a couple of feet in front of him. He thought, "Oh my God, I'm going to die over something so fucking dumb".

He turned, looked back at McKenzie who was still holding the gun pointed at his direction and looking upset. He told her okay, okay while holding his hands up. He turned away with his back toward McKenzie and knelt down; placing one hand on the asphalt in an attempt to get momentum to run away. McKenzie shot at him again, striking the asphalt. The debris/fragments struck him on the chin and fell over and rolled. After the shots, he heard Deputy Abhau but didn't see McKenzie. He ran around the corner and a second deputy stopped him. Then, he realized he was shot and bleeding. The witnesses, PBSO Deputy Abhau and Oscar L. Ticas, observed McKenzie standing in the middle of the street and shooting at the victim. On the street, in front of McKenzie's residence, spent casings were recovered. A search of McKenzie's home revealed a spent casing, a projectile, and three live rounds.

During a voluntary statement, McKenzie stated she couldn't recall most of the incident except Santos "choking the shit out of her" on the bed, getting scared, and retrieved the firearm from her nightstand. McKenzie stated the first bullet would not fire causing her to charge the firearm at the dining area. McKenzie couldn't recall where she placed her clothing after the shooting. The clothing was later found in McKenzie's washing machine. McKenzie didn't exhibit any signs of redness or injury to her neck. I noted McKenzie had an odor of alcohol emanating from her breath and person.

NARRATIVE CONTINUATION

Based on the evidence and witness statements, probable cause was established to charge McKenzie with Aggravated Battery with a Firearm in violation of F.S.S. 784.045 (1)a(1&2).
