



Disabilities Act of 1990, as amended, to which act Defendant was subject and by which act Plaintiff was protected in his employment with Defendant.


6. Subsequent to Defendant's ADA violations, Plaintiff timely filed charges with the US EEOC, has received his notice of right to sue, and has timely commenced this action. Plaintiff has also timely filed a claim notice with Defendant relative to his workers' compensation tort claim, and timely commences this action after denial thereof.
7. As a result of Defendant's treatment of Plaintiff in the premises, Plaintiff has lost wages and will lose wages in the future and has endured and will endure emotional distress, and has been otherwise damaged.

WHEREFORE, premises considered, Plaintiff prays for judgment against Defendant in a sum in excess of \$10,000, interest, costs, attorneys' fees, reinstatement to his position, and such other and further equitable relief to which he is deemed entitled.
