## PETITION FOR INJUNCTIVE AND DECLARATORY RELIEF

Petitioner, Todd A. Lowder III, respectfully files this Petition for Injunctive and Declaratory Relief and states:

#### I. INTRODUCTION

- 1. This petition arises from the unlawful access, use, and reliance upon protected juvenile-origin records by the DC Fire & EMS Department ("FEMS") and the Police & Fire Clinic ("PFC") during Petitioner's 2025 Employment Suitability Assessment (ESA) for the Fire Cadet Program.
- 2. Petitioner was 17 years old during the MPD Cadet preemployment psychological and background screening. Under D.C. Code §§ 16-2331 and 16-2332, these are confidential juvenile case and social records.
- 3. On September 26, 2025, FEMS rescinded Petitioner's conditional offer and declared him "not psychologically suited", relying in whole or in part on juvenile records created while he was a minor.

#### II. FACTS

- 4. Multiple FEMS officials confirmed or referenced reliance on juvenile records:
  - a. Lt. Davis directly informed Petitioner that the ESA decision was based on the MPD Cadet psychological file.

- b. Chief Ward, after Petitioner cited juvenile-record laws, reversed that explanation and claimed juvenile records were not used.
- c. Assistant Chief Kishia Clemencia, in a written decision, asserted the Police & Fire Clinic "relied on all information in its possession, including MPD Cadet information."
- 5. Petitioner signed a general adult release on July 18, 2025. That release:
  - o did not mention juvenile records
  - o did not identify any juvenile materials
  - did not request his explicit adult consent for juvenileorigin information
- 6. Juvenile-record confidentiality is statutory, mandatory, and not waivable by a broad release. D.C. Code §§ 16-2331 and 16-2332 expressly prohibit disclosure, inspection, or use of juvenile records except under narrow statutory exceptions.
- 7. The law requires either:
  - a. explicit, record-specific adult consent referencing juvenile materials, or
  - b. a Family Court order pursuant to D.C. Code § 16-2331(c)–(f).
- 8. Respondent produced no court order and no statutory authority authorizing its reliance on juvenile records.
- 9. Despite multiple written requests, Respondent has refused to identify:
  - o what records were accessed,
  - the legal authority for using juvenile-origin materials,
     or
  - o the basis of the ESA determination.

#### III. LEGAL GROUNDS

A. Statutory confidentiality of juvenile case records

D.C. Code § 16-2331(b):

"Juvenile case records shall be kept confidential and shall not be open to inspection, except as provided in this subchapter."

D.C. Code § 16-2331(i):

"No person shall disclose, inspect, or use juvenile case records

in violation of this section."

B. Statutory confidentiality of juvenile social records

D.C. Code § 16-2332(b):

"Juvenile social records shall be kept confidential and shall not be disclosed except as provided in this subchapter."

C. Use of juvenile records for employment is prohibited

D.C. Code § 16-2335(c):

"A person whose juvenile records are sealed shall not be required to disclose such records in an application for employment."

D. A private release cannot override statutory protections

Statutory rights cannot be waived by private contract.

A general release cannot authorize unlawful inspection or use of juvenile records.

E. No valid path for disclosure was used

D.C. Code § 16-2331(c)-(f) requires Family Court authorization before any disclosure to outside agencies.

No such authorization exists.

#### IV. RELIEF REQUESTED

Petitioner respectfully requests the Court to:

A. DECLARE

That FEMS' use of juvenile-origin MPD Cadet records violated:

- ·D.C. Code § 16-2331
- D.C. Code § 16-2332
- •D.C. Code § 16-2335
- and related confidentiality statutes.

**B. Disclosure Requires a Court Order** 

D.C. Code § 16-2331(c)-(f)

provides the only lawful methods to release juvenile records, all requiring Family Court approval.

Defendants never obtained a court order.

C. Juvenile Confidentiality Is Mandatory and Non-Waivable

A private release cannot override a statute.

Plaintiff's July 18, 2025 release was general, did not reference juvenile records, and cannot erase the confidentiality mandates of §§16-2331 and 16-2332.

D. The Law Forbids Use of Juvenile Records for Employment Barriers

D.C. Code § 16-2335(c):

"A person whose juvenile records are sealed shall not be required to disclose such records in an application for employment."

The legislative intent is clear: juvenile information cannot block adult employment.

#### V. CLAIMS

#### **COUNT I – Declaratory Judgment**

(Under D.C. Code § 2-501)

Plaintiff seeks a declaration that:

- 1. Defendants unlawfully accessed and used juvenile-origin MPD records.
- 2. Plaintiff's general release did not authorize disclosure of juvenile materials.
- 3. Any suitability finding based on juvenile materials is invalid.

#### **COUNT II - Writ of Mandamus**

Plaintiff seeks a writ compelling Defendants to:

- Identify all juvenile-origin materials accessed, reviewed, or held.
- 2. Provide the legal authority they relied upon.
- 3. Produce all records relied on in Plaintiff's ESA (excluding those barred by statute).
- 4. Correct Plaintiff's suitability designation if it was influenced by illegal juvenile data.

#### VI. REQUEST FOR RELIEF

Plaintiff respectfully requests that this Court:

- 1. Issue a Declaratory Judgment stating that Defendants violated D.C. Code §§16-2331 and 16-2332 by accessing or using juvenile records.
- 2. Issue a Writ of Mandamus compelling Defendants to:
  - · identify all records relied upon,
  - produce non-statutorily protected materials,
  - and correct Plaintiff's suitability designation.
- 3. Order a new ESA review excluding juvenile-origin information.
- 4. Award court costs and any further relief the Court deems just.
